Between 1805-1807, Samuel, wife Ann and two small daughters, Elizabeth and Susanna came into Ohio from Pennsylvania. Living close by was James Wilgus, who may be his father or uncle, and his wife Catherine. He settled on land in Concord Twp., Ross County, near Frankfort. When he died in 1857, he owned 73 acres of land #1975 and 35 acres land #5495.

Samuel is buried at Day Cemetery, Ross County, Ohio; Located on east side of the intersection of Goodhope Road and Sever Road, abt. two miles west of Austin. The headstones read as follows:

I don't know for sure where Samuel was born; 1850 Census has Pennsylvania and son Samuel Lorenzo, age 14 when his father died, said born in Pennsylvania. But, on 1880 Census his daughters, Susanna, from his first marriage, 42 when he died, and Nancy Ann, 21 when he died, both said he was born in Maryland.

On 1790 Census, Hartford Co. Maryland, there is a James Wilgus whose family fits this one.

Regiment was organized at Camp Dennison, Ohio May 8-11, 1864, to serve for 100 days. It was composed of the 27th Regiment, Ohio National Guard from Ross County and 55th. Battalion from Clinton County. On May 11 it left Ohio for Baltimore, Md. where it was assigned to duty at various forts in and near the city, remaning there until May 29 when it was ordered to eastern shore of Maryland and distributed at different points. About July 4 it was ordered to Monocacy Junction and on the 9th. took part in an engagement with the enemy. The regiment lost about 30 killed and wounded and 100 in prisoners. After this battle it took part with the 6th. and 19th. Corps in marches in Maryland and Virginia. Portions of the regiment were with the 144th. when it was attacked by Mosby's guerillas at Berryville, Va. The regiment returned to Ohio on Aug. 20, 1864 and was mustered out on the 29th. Acute Indigestion Takes Samuel L. Wilges Early Sunday Morning Samuel L. Wilges, 81, oldest resident of Buckland and resident of that village for more then three quarters of a century, died at the home of his son, Marion Wilges Sunday morning, June 15, 1924 at 7 o'clock. Acute indigestion was the immediate cause of his death. He had taken ill last Friday afternoon at 4 o'clock and his condition grew rapidly worse until death occurred Sunday morning. The deceased was widely know and highly respected in Buckland and Logan Township. He was a farmer for many years and for the last ten years has been in charge of a shoe repair shop at Buckland. For many years he had been a member of the Ohio National guard.

His wife preceded him in death several years ago and since that time he has made his home with his son Marion. He is survived by three sons, Marion Wilges, Jesse Wilges and Albert Wilges, all of Buckland and one daughter, Catherine (Mrs. John Young) who resides in Michigan. A host of other relatives and friends mourn his death. Services will be held at M.E. Church where for many years he was a member, Tuesday afternoon, if his daughter arrives from Michigan. Rev. Herbert Walker will be in charge and burial will be at Buckland Cemetery.

THE DAILY REPORTER, Wapakoneta, Auglaize Co., Ohio Monday June 16, 1924 -Samuel L. Wilgus, an old and highy respected resident of Buckland, passed to the Great Beyond at the home of his son in Buckland, Sunday morning, June 15, 1924, after a brief illness. Mr. Wilgus had been enjoying reasonably good health but on Saturday he was siezed with an attack of acute indigestion and he was given immediate medical attention his condition gradually grew worse and he passed peacefully away. Mr Wilgus had been making his home with his sons at Buckland for some time since the death of his companion.
